Dear Pleasantside Parents and Families,

Welcome to the 2026 school year! Whether you are a new or returning family to Pleasantside, we look forward to working with you and your child(ren) this year. I am very excited about the start of the school year and look forward to working with all of our amazing families this year. Below are some first week and general start up information for you. On Tuesday, September 8th, school will begin at 8:45 a.m. and will finish at 9:15 a.m.

- Last Year Divisions 1 -- 6 students will report to their positions on the blacktop.
- Kindergarten students will be met by Mrs. Bojic and Ms. Karod the entrance ramp next to the drive thru.
- New students will meet with Mr. Morton on the black couches in the foyer outside the office.

Kindergarten students will have received a two-week gradual schedule that is unique to each child, Welcoming Conversations with teachers will be booked early next week.

Full day classes for students in grades 1 – 5 will begin on Wednesday, September 9th from 8:45 am to 2:50 pm., and students will report to the blacktop where they will line up based on last year's divisions until final class placements are made at the end of the week. As we have some new registrations and enrolment numbers are changing, we are always required by the school district to wait until we receive their direction to move students into their permanent classes for the year.

Please know that the placement of children into classes is a thoughtful process that involves hours of planning and input from all members of staff. Once we assign students to permanent class placements, we hope you will talk with your child about the positive aspects of their classroom placement and let them know that there will be opportunities for friendships old and new to flourish both in and out of the classroom setting throughout the year. In a school our size there are many opportunities for classes to combine for activities both in and out of the classroom setting. We have an amazing staff that will ensure all students have a great place to learn throughout the upcoming year.

If you live close to Pleasantside, we hope you will take advantage of the opportunity to walk to school. This is a great way to connect with your child and help them get off to a good start to the school day. The recommended drop off is at the end of the drive-thru off Barber Street between 8:35 and 8:45am. Please drop your children off and they are welcome to walk up the ramp where they will be safely supervised by staff members before the 8:45am school bell. Please drive with caution through our school zone, especially during the first month of start-up. For pick-up, please follow the same procedures to ensure safe exiting for all of our children at the end of the day. Please teach your children to use the crosswalks to safely navigate our parking lot. The upper parking lot is for staff parking, day care workers and accessible parking only. Please do not enter the staff parking lot during drop off or pick up.
