

AUTOMOTIVE SHOPS – SERVICE OF AUTOMOBILES

Background

Customers must be made aware of the risk involved when their automobiles are left in a school automotive shop.

Procedures

1. The following clause is to be incorporated as part of the work order which the customer signs:

Name of Secondary School - Automotive Shop

Date

I hereby authorize repairs and service to be performed on my vehicle as set out on the attached work order on the understanding that no warranty is given with respect to the quality of the work or as to the time when it will be completed. I understand that the Board of School Trustees of School District No. 43 (Coquitlam) or the school accepts no responsibility for loss by theft or damage to the vehicle or the contents thereof.

Signature of Owner

2. The automotive instructor shall ensure that the vehicle left for service is currently licensed and covered by the comprehensive or specified perils (fire and theft insurance). If the automobile is not insured or if the insurance expires while the automobile is in the shop, the owner must have the vehicle covered by an 'in-storage policy' which would protect against fire and theft.
