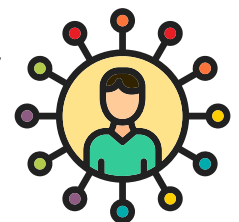

Registration & Commitment:

Students are registering for the full 10-month Theatre Company, and a commitment to all three terms is required. Throughout the year, students will be assigned roles and work together as an ensemble toward a year-end performance. As each student plays an important part in bringing the production to life, consistent participation throughout the full program is essential. Please ensure your child can commit to the September–June program before registering. No previous theatre experience is required, we welcome students of all experience levels!
