Things you need to know for districts:

- 1) Wednesday November 19th (Day #1), has all schools playing in a round robin tournament.
- 2) We will be following the rules sent out at the beginning of the season. Please re-read the rules prior to the tournament.
- 3) On the first night of the District Championships when games are timed, the games will go until the timer buzzes. There is the potential for your team to win by more than 25 points.

****Please coach your players to play through the buzzer since the ball is in play until the point is over.****

- 4) Thursday November 20th (Day #2), has Girls teams playing at Moody and Boys teams playing at Eagle Mountain. The second night is single elimination.
- 5) The girls pools will have three teams (per pool) advancing to night #2. The boys pools will have two teams (per pool) advancing to night #2.
- 6) For the Girls Day #2 tournament, the first place teams from each pool on day 1 will have a bye to the semi-final.
- 7) **At the end of Day #1, it is imperative that host schools send a photo of your completed scoring table and results to**

2025 TOURNAMENT FORMAT

1. All teams will play a round robin starting at 3:30pm, on Wednesday (Night #1). Night #2 will be best of three sets.
2. On night 1, all teams will play until time expires with a 2 minute change over. Play out point if buzzer rings. This means that if your scheduled time says 12 minutes, it is actually 10 because you have to include the 2 minute change over.
3. Regular League rules will apply (except scoring/timing system).
4. One 20-second time-out per game permitted. No time-outs in last 5 min.
5. Net height 2.20 m for boys and 2.05 m for girls

6. Try to keep games on time. This is a must – please be ready and warmed up for your games so we may finish on time. Please do not arrive at host schools too early.
7. To ensure equal playing time during timed matches on night 1, coaches must keep the same rotation throughout the entire night and players will start in the same position they finished at in the previous game.
 - On Night #2, when games are best of three sets. At the end of each set, you may restart your rotation.
8. Poor sportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated and will result in an automatic red card (loss of point). A second infraction and any subsequent infractions during that match will result in the offending player missing a rotation.

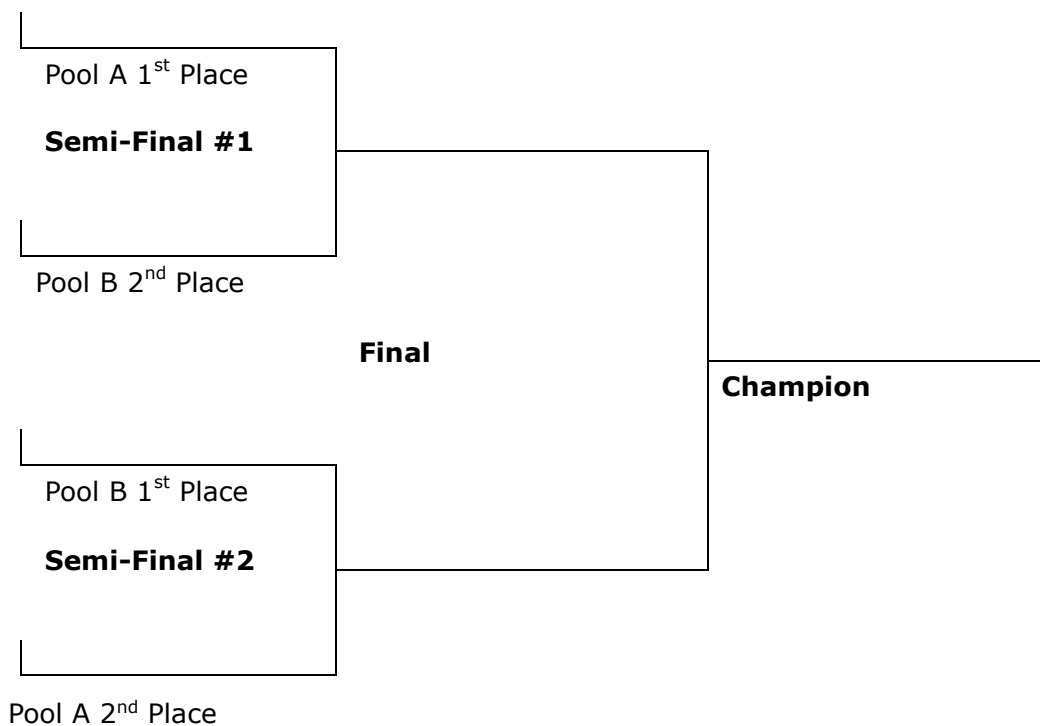

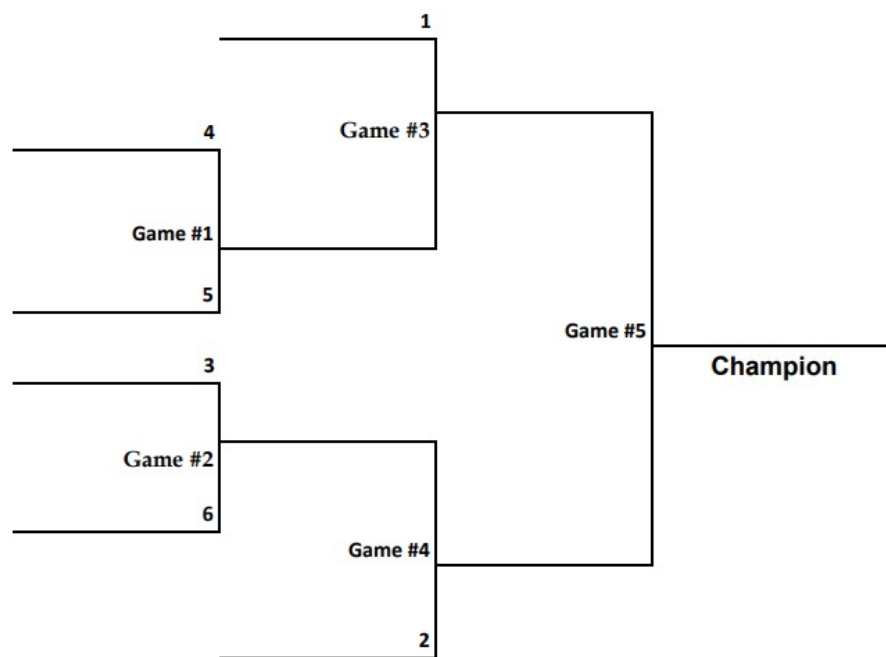
