SchoolCash Online (SCO)

You will need to create an online account to pay for things or approve activities. When you create an account, make sure to **OPT IN** to receive email notifications for new items.

Parent Volunteer Forms

Parents wishing to volunteer for field trips or in the classroom this school year must have 2 documents on file with the school:

1 - District School Volunteer Application Form – this document will be available on SchoolCash Online by end of day Friday September 11th and must be completed each year. If you have 2 parents wishing to volunteer, please let Ms. Reeves know so she can post an extra form for your student. Or, if you have more than one student at the school, parents can each complete one student's form.

2 – Criminal Record Check – these documents are valid for 5 years. If you already have an active one on file with the school, you do not need to complete another. (if you aren't sure if yours is still valid, email Ms. Reeves) If you need to get a criminal record check done, please email Ms. Reeves for the letter to take to the Coquitlam RCMP.

Medical Alert Forms

If your child has any medical issues that the school should be aware of, please complete the necessary Medical Alert form(s) found on our school website and return it/them to Ms. Reeves in the office. The forms can be found by clicking on the "Parent eForms" quick link on the school website homepage and then scrolling to the bottom of the page.
