In British Columbia, you must be 16 years or older to legally operate an e-scooter.

You also need to be in a community that allows e-scooters.



Check your municipality's rules before buying or riding.



How to ride safely



Always wear a properly fitted helmet

It's the best way to protect your head.



Stay alert and avoid distractions such as phones and headphones

Keep your full attention on the road and your surroundings.



Ride one person per scooter

Scooters are designed for one rider.



Use lights and reflective gear

It helps others see you.



Slow down, especially on uneven or wet surfaces

Go slower to stay in control and avoid falls.
