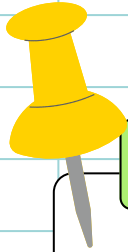

Start-of-year items have been added to School Cash Online. Please log in to review your account and ensure that all required forms and fees have been completed.

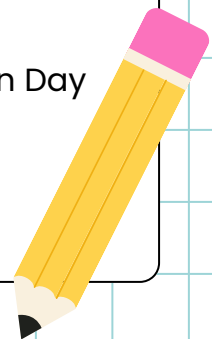
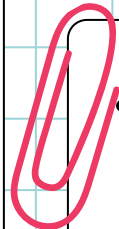

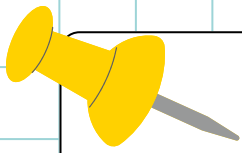

Celebrating the Legacy of Terry Fox

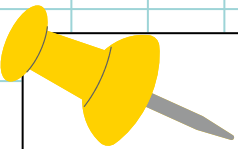

This week, AJ from the Terry Fox Foundation joined us to speak with all of our students about Terry's journey, his dream to raise money for cancer research, and his unwavering determination to make a difference. It was an inspiring day as our students learned that even in the face of tremendous challenges, one person can create a lasting impact. Terry's story reminds us of the power of perseverance and the importance of believing in what is possible. 3. **Donate directly to our school:** Families can also make a donation directly to Pleasantside Elementary using the same Terry Fox fundraising link.





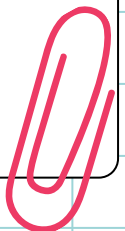
We All Belong Here



During our opening week at Pleasantside, we were honoured to welcome **Sahara Billy, an Indigenous Grade 12 student in SD43**, who shared three incredible dance performances with our school community. Sahara beautifully explained the significance of her regalia and the important role that dance holds within Indigenous culture. One of her dances invited our entire school to participate, creating a particularly powerful and memorable moment of connection, joy, and belonging.

Building on this experience, we embraced the theme **“We All Belong”** and spent meaningful time coming together as a school community. Through our morning assemblies, students explored the power and significance of our **Indigenous Welcome Post**, reflecting on its meaning and considering what the Indigenous animals represented on the post can teach us about connection, community, and belonging. We also took important time to learn about **Land Acknowledgements**, discussing why they are meaningful and beginning to consider how we might create our own personalized Land Acknowledgement later this year.

These moments provided powerful opportunities for our students to listen, reflect, ask questions, and deepen their understanding of Indigenous culture, the land, and the people connected to it. Most importantly, our opening week reminded us that belonging is created when we take the time to learn from one another, honour our shared community, and recognize that **we all have a place here at Pleasantside**.
