

STUDENT DROP-OFF PROCEDURES

Help us create a safe and smooth morning for all by following these expectations –

1. Stopping in the drop-off lane is limited to 2 minutes. This is more than enough time for parents to safely support their child(ren) in exiting their vehicle. The morning drop-off lane is not for parking.

If you need to escort your child to their class and wait with them, you need to find a parking spot either in the parent parking lot or on one of the streets near the school.

2. When dropping off in the drop-off lane, where possible, move forward to the first open space.

If people stop at the back of the drop off lane, traffic often backs up from there. I realize that most of the students line up at the back of the school, but moving forward will not add that much time to their walk.

3. Do not let your child out of your vehicle unless you are in the drop-off lane. We do not want kids moving in and out of traffic. **CHOOSE SAFETY OVER CONVENIENCE.**

To clarify, there are 3 lanes. The lane that follows the sidewalk is the drop-off lane. The middle and far lanes are THRU-LANES. DO NOT STOP in either of those two thru-lanes to drop-off your child.

4. Parents are expected to remain in or at their vehicles and then to move their vehicle out once their child has left.

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Should our parking lot be full or too busy, this satellite image highlights areas on adjacent streets where parents can park (green) and can't park (red).
